Combined Relatedness Index: 246,088

The DNA from the alleged mother was compared to the tested child. Based on testing results obtained from the analyses of the DNA loci listed, the probability of relatedness is 99.9995%. The likelihood that the alleged relatives are the biological relatives of the tested child is 246,088 to 1. This probability of relatedness was calculated by comparing to untested, unrelated, random individuals of the Caucasian population (assumes prior probability equals 0.50).

Note: Since the samples were not collected under a strict chain of custody by a third neutral party and the Laboratory cannot verify the origin of the samples, this test result may not be defensible in a court of law for the establishment of paternity and other legally related issues. The tested parties' names that may appear on this report have been provided by the client and cannot be verified.
